

- If you have any queries regarding these instructions, contact your local dealer for clarification before you use your Tripod Fan.
- Always remove unit from all packaging materials prior to use.
- Failure to follow the manual's instructions could result in damage or serious injury.
- Disconnect the power plug before dismantling, assembling or before cleaning.
- Avoid touching moving parts of the Tripod Fan.
- Make sure the fan is on a dry, even and level surface.
- Never insert fingers, or any other objects though the guards whenever the power plug is connected, especially when the tripod fan is running.
- Do not use the appliance for any other purpose than its intended use.
- Do not leave the product unattended while it is in use, especially when children are present. Always unplug the product from the electrical outlet when it is not in use.
- Do not place the product in or near an open window. Rain, snow, and other weather elements may create an electrical hazard.
- Keep the power cord and product away from sharp edges and heated surfaces.









ASSEMBLING THE FAN

 Insert the three tripod legs into the holes of the tripod leg holder, up to the mark indicated on each leg. Tighten the screws on the leg holder to secure the tripod legs Fig.1

The tripod should be opened to the maximum angle and secured.




2. Assemble the motor housing (9) to the top of the telescopic stand (6) Fig.2



- 3. First remove the pivot screw (7) and the bolt (19) from the top of the telescopic stand, then remove the small retaining screw (20) and Tilt adjustment screw (8) from the motor housing bracket.
- 4. Place the motor housing on the top of the stand and thread the large pivot bolt (19) through the bracket. Screw in the small retaining screw (20) and tighten, but do not overtighten.
- 5.Fit the large pivot screw (7) onto the end of the bolt (19) and screw the Tilt adjustment screw (8) at the other side above the bolt. Tighten the screws while holding the fan motor upright.

Ensure the product is fully assembled before plugging into an electrical outlet.



- 6. First remove any protective sleeve from the motor spindle (12) and the four rear guard retaining screws from the motor housing.
- 7.Attach the rear guard (4) to the motor housing (9) using the four screws you just removed. Ensure the handle is at the top.
- 8. Place the fan blade (3) over the motor spindle (12) and tighten the fan blade retaining screw (13), ensuring that it tightens against the flat part on the motor spindle (12).
- 9.Remove the front guard screw and nut (2 & 5) from the front guard and turn the guard retaining clips around the outside edge outwards. Hang the front guard by its hook over the top of the rear guard.
- 10.Bring the front guard down to meet the rear guard and push the clips inwards until the front guard is fastened to the rear guard.
- 11. Finally fit the guard screw through the holes in the bottom edge of the guard and tighten with the nut.

OPERATING THE FAN

- This Fan is for domestic use, it is not intended for industrial or commercial use. Your Fan is safe and easy to use.
- 2. Place the fan on a flat, level surface and ensure it is stable.
- 3. Ensure all 3 tripod legs are opened to maximum angle.
- 4. Insert the plug into the wall socket, making sure the power cable is not taut and not in a walkway where it can be tripped over.
- 5. Adjust fan speed by rotating the speed dial to the desired position.
 - 0 OFF
 - 1 LOW
 - 2 MEDIUM
 - 3 HIGH
- For the fan to oscillate automatically from left to right, press down on the oscillation knob at the top of the motor housing. To stop oscillation, pull up on the same knob.
- 7. To tilt the fan head, loosen the pivot adjustment knob (7) slightly and also the tilt adjustment screw (8). Adjust fan head to the desired position and retighten the two knobs. The fan must be switched off when doing this adjustment.
- To adjust the height, loosen the height adjustment screw(15), pull out or push down the extension pole to the desired height then retighten screw (15) firmly.

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

- The appliance, the power cord and the power plug must not be immersed in water or other liquids when you are cleaning them. Clean them with a dry cloth.
- If it is very dirty, the outside of the appliance can be wiped carefully with a moist cloth and then dried carefully.
 Make sure that no moisture penetrates into the interior of the appliance.
- Do not use any harsh cleaners, steel brushes, scouring powder or other hard objects to clean the appliance as these can cause scratches on the surfaces.
- · Clean the appliance regularly.
- Never use solvents, benzene or oil-based cleaners as these can damage the housing.
- Re-tighten visible screw connections on the appliance regularly in order to ensure that the device is functioning properly.

DISPOSAL

Used electric household devices

- If you do not require your electrical appliance any longer, dispose of it at a recycling depot for used electric appliances.
- Used electric devices must not be disposed of with normal houshold rubbish

Further disposal instructions:

- Return the electrical appliance in such a condition that its later re-use or recycling is not adversely affected.
- If applicable, batteries must be removed in advance and the destruction of parts which contain fluids must be avoided.

TROUBLE SHOOTING

| Problem | Solution |
|---|---|
| The force of air coming from the unit is weak | Adjust the speed to a higher setting |
| The unit does not work | Check that the plug is connected and that the unit is switched on at the mains supply |
| Other abnormal conditions | Disconnect the fan from the wall socket and consult a repair specialist |
